### Directions For Use

1. Dampen a soft, clean cloth with Lemon Oil.
2. Wipe wood surface thoroughly.
3. Remove any excess and lightly buff surface.
4. Use Lemon Oil regularly on wood surfaces to restore moisture and help prevent drying and cracking.
